## PROJECT PROFILE: BOEING BUS/CREW SHELTERS

### Project Manager: Chip Wilson

Progress continues steadily on the Boeing project, where H&W Electrical currently has 11 buildings under contract. To date, one building has reached substantial completion, marking an important milestone for the team.

Work is actively underway on three North Crew Shelters, with all grounding and underground electrical installations now complete for those facilities. Additionally, of the three Bus Shelters contracted, one has also achieved substantial completion.

Looking ahead, construction activities for the remaining four Crew Shelters, two Bus Shelters, and the Central Utility Building are scheduled to begin later this year as the project continues to advance.
